1. What is meant by social well-being?

Social well-being refers to the desire for the betterment and welfare of all individuals in a society.

2. What is meant by respect for humanity?

Respect for humanity means treating every person with dignity and respect, regardless of their race, color, religion, or background.

3. What is the Hadith related to social well-being?

The Prophet (PBUH) said, "Religion is sincerity."

Examples of Companions' Lives

1. Example of respect for humanity from the life of Hazrat Ali (RA)?

Hazrat Ali (RA) said, "Allah has given superiority to the dignity and honor of Muslims over all other dignities."

**Avoiding Moral Vices** 

1. What is meant by prejudice?

Prejudice means unfairly favoring or discriminating against someone based on their race, color, religion, or background.

2. What is meant by self-conceit?

Self-conceit means considering oneself superior to others and looking down on them.

3. Quranic verse about self-conceit?

The Quran says, "And do not claim yourselves to be pure."

4. Three things that can ruin a person according to Hadith?

The Prophet (PBUH) said, "Three things can ruin a person: stinginess, following one's desires, and self-conceit."

Social Relations and Ethics

1. Importance of good ethics and manners in Hadith?

The Prophet (PBUH) said, "The most perfect believer in faith is one who is best in conduct and is kind to his family."

2. What is meant by social relations?

Social relations refer to the connections and interactions between individuals in a society.
